Minimum Requirements

- Be between 18 and 35 years of age.
- Have a Grade 12 (Matric) Certificate.
- Submit a certified copy of their South African ID.
- Provide valid proof of residence (municipal bill, Tribal Authority letter, or other acceptable proof).
- Reside within a 30-kilometre radius of one of the participating programme sites, surrounding communities, or recognised land claimant areas.
- Declare in the application letter if they have previously participated in any Department of Tourism learnership or skills development programme.
- Have a genuine passion for travel, tourism, and hospitality.
- Have a clear criminal record.
