Required Application Documents

Applications must include:

- A comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- Certified copy of South African Identity Document.
- Certified copies of qualifications and academic transcripts.
- Proof of residential address.
- A sworn affidavit confirming that the applicant has not previously participated in an internship programme.
- TVET applicants must submit:
 - Certified N6 Certificate.
 - Official WIL placement letter.
- Clearly indicate the relevant reference number for the position being applied for.
